- 3. The work will result in a high-quality product and meet the specifications listed under Scope of Work and Technical Requirements.
- 4. We will make preference for the purchase, acquisition, or use of goods, products, or materials produced in the United States as defined in 2 CFR §200.322 Domestic preferences for procurements.
- 5. We will complete and submit in a timely manner all documentation required by the County.
- 6. We have or will obtain at our own cost general liability coverage with a limit of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate; professional liability coverage with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate; and worker's compensation coverage meeting State of NH required limits and providing employer's liability coverage. We will submit at the time a contract is executed a current certificate of insurance from a company licensed to issue such insurance in the State of New Hampshire.
- 7. We are not debarred, suspended, or otherwise prohibited from receiving federal funds.
- 8. We are familiar with and will comply with the following federal rules, which are expressly applicable to this project.
  - a. Submission of a proposal in effect provides the contractor's official assurance acknowledging the contractor is familiar with and will comply with the following federal rules, which are expressly applicable to this project. Davis-Bacon Requirements in summary state that all laborers and mechanics employed by the contractor in the performance of the scope of work of a proposal in excess of \$2,000 shall be paid wages at a rate not less than those prevailing on similar projects in the locality, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with subchapter IV of chapter 31 of title 40,

United States Code commonly referred to as the "Davis-Bacon Act". - d. We will comply with Affirmative Action and Pay Transparency Requirements.
- 9. We are registered with Sam.gov, have a verifiable UEI number and an unexpired registration date.
- 10. Neither the firm, nor any key employees who will work on the project are debarred, suspended, or otherwise restricted from receiving federal funds.
